All of our waffles are vegetarian, apart from our bacon and maple syrup morning waffle - the bacon this year will be locally sourced.

We also offer a range of vegan options as we too believe this is important.

This year we are introducing waffle sticks as a smaller portion option to reduce calories and food waste.

Drinking water is provided for free at The Boathouse and we also offer free water bottle refills if asked.

We offer 25p discount on food and drink if customers can bring their own food container or cup.

We try to source all of our waffle ingredients and toppings locally wherever possible.
