1 General update on any activities since last meeting

- Since the last C&T meeting the Summer Sessions have been taking place on the Killacourt.
- The Sunday 11th July music event had to be cancelled due to poor weather. The Rock Choir Cornwall was rescheduled to Sunday 18th July and The Stowes have been rescheduled to play Sunday 8th August.
- On Sunday 18th July there was an issue with a group of homeless inebriated individuals that hang out by the Changing Places toilets with one invading the stage whilst banging his drum and trying to sing whilst The Rock Choir Cornwall were performing. The situation was calmed down by Matthew. A police report has been filed regarding the incident.
- The Saturday 24th July external event by Culture 76 was cancelled due to their bar manger having a severe injury from a fall and could not work. They were unable to find a replacement.
- Another external event, CornWell Fest due to take place Saturday September 4th has now been cancelled due funding issues, current covid climate and lack of staffing.
- Paperwork received for external event Skate Jam taking place at Concrete Waves all approved for Saturday 14th August.
- A pane of glass was broken on the bandstand back in June. This was replaced 26th July.

3 Any key issues the Manager/Working Party/Lead Member wishes to draw to the committee's attention

- **Parking** – During summertime parking is an issue for event performers.
- **Marquee** – Is not in good shape at first sight. The Environmental team are going to put the Marquee up in the Mount Wise car park to view if it is repairable week commencing 23rd August. Possibly required for Summer Finale on the 21st September and Civic Parade currently planned for Sunday 26th September.
- **Bins/Waste removal** – Bins on the Killacourt are currently being emptied by the Events Coordinator after each event however this has proved more difficult due to the large bin

compound being full and the waste having to be hand carried up to the waste compound at the Marcus Hill offices - Joe Ashton looking into the bin/waste removal issue.

- **Security** – After the Stage invasion event security has now been requested and confirmed for all the rest of the Summer Sessions. All future events will also have security presence going forward.
- **Heavy vehicles** - An external event the Youth and Community Bus Tour. They were allowed to park their double decker bus on the reinforced tarmac area on Killacourt. The bus was too heavy and the wheels left large indents on the tarmac. These have now been filled in by APS.

- Mural on the back of the bandstand to brighten it up.
- A-frames or a poster-frame on the side of the bandstand (attached to the gate on the right-hand side of bandstand) to display upcoming performances and line-ups at events.

Currently planning for the Civic Parade which has now been rescheduled to Sunday 26th September and the Summer finale on Saturday 18th September. Only issue to arise so far is the use of the marquee at both events.
