LICENSING OBJECTIVES

Describe the steps you intend to take to promote the four licensing objectives:

a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e)

List here steps you will take to promote all four licensing objectives together.

The premises license holder will continue to actively promote the four licensing objectives into the extension of time for licensable activities and onto the forecourt.

We are currently undergoing a huge refurb which will promote the four licensing objectives by making the patrons more visable to staff and security due to new layout and increased CCTV cameras. The premises has also been made more safe by having all walls and ceilings fireboarded and having exits widened at front and back.

We are adding numerous sound proofing measures to avoid public nuisance and we plan on increasing the hours worked by our security staff.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

Staying open and serving alcohol later plus the addition of a licensed forecourt would mean continuation of our zero tolerance approach to drugs. We will install CCTV on the outside forecourt and the manager will have access to a screen in which to view the footage and look out for any illegal or disruptive behaviour.

Proof of age is required to avoid the serving of alcohol to under 18s and this will continue into the extended license time. Staff will be sure to ID patrons on the forecourt and will keep a keen eye on activity so that drinks can not be purchased by someone and given to an under aged person outside.

We will continue to enforce a challenge 25 policy.

Customers will be reminded with a written sign not to take their drinks away from the forecourt.

The building is currently undergoing a big refurb which includes brand new toilets with recessed cisterns making it impossible for the surface to be used for drugs.

We have a new layout and have removed some walls which makes the customers more visible to staff and security on the door, reducing temptation for illegal activity.

We have increased the number of CCTV cameras on site including the bathroom lobby.

c) Public safety

The premises is undergoing a huge refurb including fireboarding of all the walls and ceilings and installation of a fire alarm. Every single part of the building is brand new and in excellent condition including all new toilets, furniture, floors, ceilings, doors and stairs. This standard will be maintained at all times.

Equipment will continue to be tested regularly and high levels of housekeeping will be maintained.

The outside decking will be built to an excellent safe standard in line with the necessary planning permission and CCTV will

be installed and monitored.

Means of escape has been widened at both the front and back of the venue making potential evacuation quicker and safer. Staff and patron safety is always a priority.

d) The prevention of public nuisance

We always endeavour to prevent disruption and disturbance to our local residents and neighbours. This is a priority at all times.

Noise levels in the premises will continue to be controlled at all times plus we are covering over a large windowed frontage behind our stage and are also noise proofing this area on the inside, both these actions will dramatically reduce noise pollution.

We are moving our double entrance away from the stage which will limit noise escaping when the doors are opened. The outside forecourt will be cleared and cleaned quietly and noise levels will be monitored throughout the evenings. Our large and attractive range of non alcoholic drinks will be available right up into the extension of opening hours.

e) The protection of children from harm

Steps will continue to be taken to protect children from moral, psychological and physical harm.

Proof of age is required with an enforced challenge 25 policy whereby any persons looking younger than 25 is required to show ID with a hologram.

Employed security people will maintain on their post until 3.30am when the venue is completely closed and locked continuing to check for ID. Anybody using the forecourt will also be checked for ID. Staff will be sure to ID patrons on the forecourt and will keep a keen eye on activity so that drinks can not be purchased by someone and given to an under aged person outside.

NOTES ON REGULATED ENTERTAINMENT

In terms of specific **regulated entertainments** please note that:

- Plays: no licence is required for performances between 08:00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
- Films: no licence is required for 'not-for-profit' film exhibition held in community premises between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day provided that the audience does not exceed 500 and the organiser (a) gets consent to the screening from a person who is responsible for the premises; and (b) ensures that each such screening abides by age classification ratings.
- Indoor sporting events: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000.
- Boxing or Wrestling Entertainment: no licence is required for a contest, exhibition or display of Greco-Roman wrestling, or freestyle wrestling between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 1000. Combined fighting sports defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
- Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - o any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.

- Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
- Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
 - o any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - o any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
