iPAD SP1 stands for intelligent Public Access Defibrillator. It has been designed to be simple to use, easy to maintain, affordable to buy and inexpensive to run. It has many unique and beneficial features that help the user provide quality life-saving assistance. The device analyses if a person suffering from a cardiac arrest requires a 'shock' and if so, will administer this automatically, after a short count-down.

The benefits of the iPAD SP1 are:

Save precious seconds as the iPAD SP1 has a simple switch to select either the Adult or Child setting. The unit also comes with Dual Adult/Child Electrode Pads, so no Pad changes are required.

Clear audible instructions with an ambient noise detector which adjusts to noisy environments.

Nothing to break or lose with robust one-piece design. Well reputed for its high quality construction, the iPAD can be relied on to perform and endure emergency usage time after time.

If data is required, data download is simple with the device in situ. Up to five events and up to three hours per event. Should the data be required, the download process can be performed with a simple SD card. The device does not need to be sent away; software is supplied free if required.

Highly responsive when it matters most. The iPAD uses the latest in defibrillation technology to ensure that the device works as quickly as

possible. After a cycle of 2 minutes of CPR, the device can perform analysis and will be ready for shock delivery in less than 5 seconds.

External Defibsafe2 Cabinet with Heating (Lockable)

This cabinet is essential for storing and protecting an external or publicly accessible defibrillator. The locked Defibsafe2 cabinet protects the defibrillators from the weather and maintains a constant temperature to ensure the defibrillator battery is maintained in optimum working order.

Features:

- Colour: Yellow for high visibility in all conditions, perfect for outdoor use
- Material: Corrosion and impact resistant polyethylene.
- IP 66 rated to ensure the defibrillator is protected from the elements all year round.
- Unique location code allows Emergency Services to pin point your location.
- Stainless steel mechanical lock with 2 year warranty through normal use. Includes a coded keypad.
- Heated to ensure the cabinet maintains an internal temperature of between 5° and 25°.
- Energy efficient low-voltage transformer for low running costs.
- LED lighting highly visible at night time featuring an internal light.
- 3 bolt fixing to wall, ensuring a stable fixing even on uneven surfaces
- Large single handle easier to open
- 10 year warranty against damage to the outer casing

We advise the use of a qualified electrician when installing the DS2 Cabinet as it requires a standard UK mains 230v connection.

General

Defibrillators are designed to be low maintenance. BHF recommend that someone check the defibrillator once a week to ensure it hasn't been used and is in good working condition with sufficient pad and battery life, but they don't require any ongoing maintenance.

Budgeting ahead then it's worth knowing that the pads, will normally have a 2-3 year shelf life and the battery lasts for up to 5 years on standby, and this will cost approximately £250, pads will need to be replaced if they are used to treat a cardiac arrest. Every defibrillator will have an indicator to let you know the health of the device.

BHF provide a free CPR Training Kit with every defibrillator, which consists of an inflatable manikin and a DVD that teaches CPR in under an hour. Defibrillators are designed to be easy to use and so don't require any additional training. BHF have online videos that show the defibrillator in use to help potential first responders become familiar with using a defibrillator. Once purchased BHF suggest registering with 'The Circuit', it's the UK defibrillator network and is fully funded by the BHF. It will allow the ambulance service to direct people on site to the defibrillator and will provide maintenance support etc.
