A strategy for working together





- Statutory three year plan, refreshed annually this is year 1;
- **Multi-agency strategy** for tackling crime and disorder;
- **Contains the priorities** identified through the strategic assessment and agreed by local partners and groups.





Community Safety Officer Role

Three Community Safety Officers who cover the geography of Cornwall to;

- Target persistent problem places and people within the area
- Work closely with the Police Neighbourhood Teams and Police Problem Solvers to support information sharing and problem solving
- Coordinate partnership initiatives focused on reducing crime and disorder
- Manage multi agency Safer Town partnerships in 10 designated towns





What are Safer Towns?

- Priority towns identified by Safer Cornwall;
- Multi-agency initiatives to improve community safety and reduce crime and anti-social behaviour in the town through multi-agency working;
- Local Delivery Plan informed by evidence using a town profile based on multiple data sources including crime and disorder and residents views.
