

AG8.i - Application for Renewal of a Street Trading Consent, [REDACTED], Trading as: Kaatje Coffee, Esplanade Road. (Local Government (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 1982)

Good Afternoon

I am writing to inform you that **Karin Miedema** of Kaatje Coffee has applied to trade for another 12 months, on Espanade Road, Newquay, TR7 1QA in front of the Water's Edge apartments.

The following Council Policy came into force on 1 January 2022:- **“Single use and non-recyclable plastics must not be used by traders.”**

Traders are being asked to provide evidence of collection and recycling of their plastic products, this applicant has responded as follows:-

- Kaatje Koffee uses cardboard packaging (Cups, paper bags & paper straws)
- Kaatje Koffee gives the coffee grounds to her friends who use them on their allotments
- Kaatje Koffee's main season has finished now, we will set up a new account for next year with
- Biffa to collect rubbish bags & recycling.

Traders are also being asked to provide details of how they will support Cornwall Council's climate and health commitments, this applicant has confirmed the following:-

- Kaatje Koffee offers lots of vegan, vegetarian and gluten free options.
- Kaatje Koffee uses local businesses as suppliers, such as
- Newquay based patisserie CHOUKETTE and delivery service WESTCOUNTRY
- One of Kaatje Koffee's biggest supplier is Origin Coffee, a B-Crop who use a
- carbon free company for deliveries in electric vehicles, directly to the van.
- Kaatje Koffee shops locally, like Bookers in Newquay
- Kaatje Koffee offers free drinking water to customers who bring their own cup/bottle.
- Kaatje Koffee encourages people to bring their own travel mugs/hot drink cups.

I assume you have no objections to [redacted] Miedema renewing next year. However, should you wish to make any comments, please do so by 21 November 2024.
