Thank you for your comments regarding concerns over cliff stability. The MMO would like to assure you that we take your views very seriously. We can confirm that under condition [5.2.17](#), no works can take place between 1 April and 31 August. The MMO will be undertaking a review of the marine licence during this period and an update will be provided via the [selected cases](#) page. This will include a review of the geological evidence used to make the marine licence decision.

I can confirm that a method statement and a Construction Environmental Plan has been provided and approved by the MMO. This can be viewed on the MMO's [Public Register](#).
